SUBJECT: Command Policy Letter 18, DOD Civilian Uniform Standards

1. **PURPOSE.** To establish policies within Task Force Falcon concerning uniform wear of DOD Civilian Personnel.
2. **APPLICABILITY.** This policy letter applies to all military and civilian personnel assigned or attached to, serving with, accompanying, or visiting Task Force Falcon in either Kosovo or the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia (FYROM). Supplementation of this policy requires approval of the Commander, Task Force Falcon.
3. **REFERENCES.**

  - b. DA Pam 690-47, DA Civilian Employee Deployment Guide.
4. **POLICY:**
  - a. All DOD Civilians are required to wear the Battle Dress Uniform (BDU) and are responsible for maintaining a professional uniform appearance IAW AR 670-1.
  - b. ID Tags, Geneva Convention card, ID card, and KFOR badge will be on your person at all times.
  - c. DOD Civilians may wear civilian physical training clothing when off duty and when working out in the fitness center/gym.
